MOBILE PHONES and Electronic communication/display/recording devices

Having taken Police and legal advice, the following rules have been agreed by the Principal and Governors.

These rules apply to ALL students

Any mobile telephone or other communication/recording/ technology device **seen anywhere on site (including classrooms)** will be confiscated – including the SIM card./Memory Card

All mobile telephones and other communication/recording devices **must be switched OFF and kept in a bag** whilst on the college site

Any mobile telephone or other communication/recording technology that is **seen or used anywhere on site** and which is NOT college property **will be confiscated** (including the SIM card./Memory Card).

This rule is to ensure students do not do the following whilst on site:

- send/receive text messages,
 - access the internet/blog/social sites,
 - take photographs, record video or audio (unless with college equipment under staff guidance)
- Have telephone conversations whilst on site

Any electronic device containing offensive/pornographic material will be confiscated including the SIM card/memory card

Any telephone/device confiscated twice WILL NOT BE RETURNED This includes the SIM/memory card
