Textiles -'A' Level (Art and Design) Summer work

Over the next two years you will be exploring ways to follow a theme, explore processes and develop an outcome. To start this you need to choose a direction that you would like to work in.

Your work will begin by choosing one of the following starting points:

Natural - could include: nature, birth, growing, living, sea, land, space.

Man Made - could include: architecture, design, built, movement, plastic, environment, structure

Over the two years you will be able to add to or change the direction of your choice.

Task 1

Find a wide range of images that express your starting point, print out a paste in your book or on a board. You can find these online or in a book (but note down where the images come from) or you can go out a photograph and/or sketch the images. The best would be a mixture. The more you have the wider variety to be inspired from.

Task 2

Choose 5 of your favourite images from task 1 and 'respond' to them by sketching or painting an interesting part of them, using a range of mediums. This is your 'personal response' and you can sketch, paint, collage, print, sew or any other process you wish to do. The response does not need to be a direct copy but your interpretation. Be creative and enjoy!

Bring in your sketch book to your first lesson for peer discussion.
