You will study 2 units in your first year and one of the units is unit 5 and is called Meeting Individual Care and Support Needs. This unit is a coursework unit and requires a lot of written work and critical thinking skills for the higher arades.

Your task:

Produce a power point presentation or information guide/booklet and:

- Explain what is meant by the term equality with examples of equality in action
- Explain what is meant by the term diversity with examples of diversity in modern Britain (try and relate your examples to health and social care examples where you can)
- Explain what is meant by the term discrimination and bring in some examples of how discrimination can affect people negatively. For example a person of 80 with cancer being refused treatment based on their age; a young black person constantly being stopped and searched by police in their car based on the colour of their skin or a gay couple being refused a room in a bed and breakfast based on their sexuality.


