

In carnation - becoming flesh, taking human form.

- Gospels of Matthew + Luke state clearly Jesus was born fully God + fully human
- Jesus as God in human form made it easier to accept his teachings

### Jesus' God-like qualities

- + Miracles
- + Authority to forgive
- + Resurrection - power over death.

### Resurrection - raising from the dead

- Δ Jesus was laid to rest in a tomb on Good Friday.
- Δ Early Sunday morning Jesus' female followers went to produce his body for burial but it was not there & two angels told them Jesus had risen from the dead

### Importance today

- Shows Jesus divinity - overcame death
- Power of God over evil.
- Reassures Christians God will forgive them if they follow Jesus.

### Ascension - 40 days after Resurrection

\* Sentence to death by Pontius Pilate

\* Crucifixion - death by crucifixion (asphyxiation through death)

\* Jesus suffered the pain of his crucifixion

### Jesus human qualities

- + Ate, slept + cried
- + Suffered pain leading to his death



- \* A cost Jesus' sacrifice sin can no longer destroy their lives.
- \* Suffering is a part of life - God understands what the sufferer goes through.

### Salvation - To be saved from sin



- Δ Sin has separated humans from God.

### Atonement -

- Δ Shows Jesus' divine nature - overcame death
- Δ Power of God over evil.
- Δ Reassures Christians God will forgive them if they follow Jesus.

- Δ Jesus told his disciples to carry on his work before he ascended into heaven.
- Δ Paves the way for the Holy Spirit.
- Δ Jesus watching over Christians from Heaven
