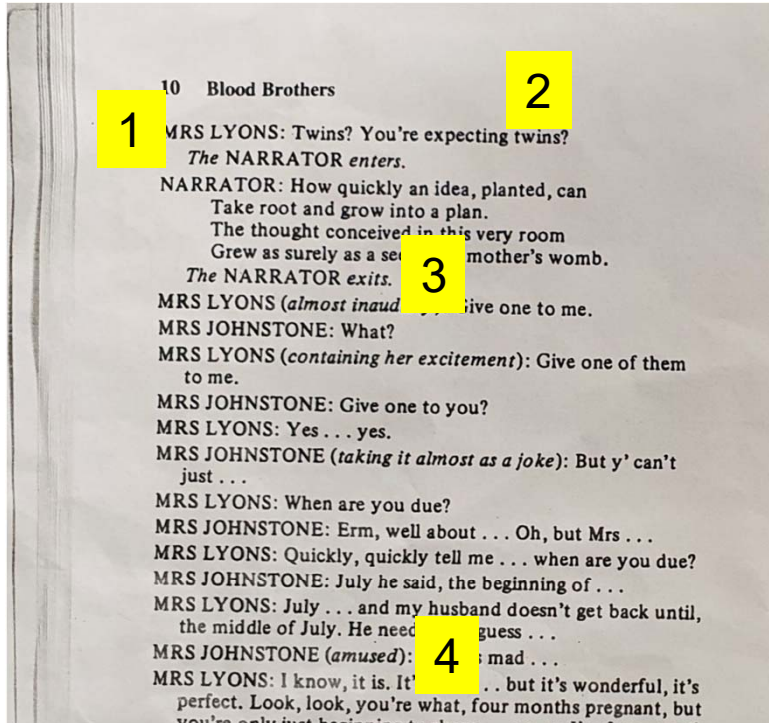


Section 1 Elements of a script



1	CHARACTER NAME	The name of the actor's character who is speaking.
2	DIALOGUE	The speech that actors need to say on stage.
3	SPEECH DIRECTION	A playwright's instruction to the actor on how to say a line of dialogue.
4	STAGE DIRECTION	A playwright's instruction to the actor on what movement or action to do on stage.

Section 2 Margaret Thatcher (Political context)

Margaret Thatcher was the Prime Minister of the UK between 1979 and 1990. One of Thatcher's central political beliefs was that **success came to those who chose to work hard**. In *Blood Brothers*, Russell **contradicts** this view. He shows a **divided** society by having Mickey and Edward attend very different schools and live in different houses. The view that having money and influential connections are necessary to become successful, is written into the play. Mickey's failure, despite his good character and hard work, is the basis of the **tragedy** in the drama.
