Section 3 The Jim Henson company

The Jim Henson Company is over 60 years old and is recognised worldwide as an **innovator** in puppetry, animatronics and digital animation. Best known as creators of the world-famous Muppets, Henson has received over 50 Emmy Awards and **nine** Grammy Awards. The Jim Henson Company is based in Los Angeles on the historic Charlie **Chaplin lot**. The Company is home to Jim Henson's **Creature Shop**, a character-building and visual effects group for international films, television shows, theme parks and advertising.









Section 2 Puppets in 'The Lion King'

Director and designer Julie Taymor, along with designer Michael Curry, hand sculpted and painted every prototype mask that now appears in the iconic "Circle of Life" opening of the show. It took approximately 37,000 hours to build all the puppets and masks; which is over **1,542** days!

There are **232 puppets** in the show, including rod, shadow and full-sized puppets. Some of these were even inspired by Japanese Bunraku puppetry.
