

Setting:

1830, Seville, Spain

Main Characters:

Carmen Gipsy
Don Jose Soldier
Escamillo Bullfighter

Story:

In a busy market square, Carmen wants to get Don Jose's attention, but he ignores her. Carmen gets into a fight, so Don Jose arrests her. Carmen escapes from prison -Don Jose is put in prison for a month as punishment. One month later, Carmen is in a tavern (a pub) - Escamillo is trying to talk to her, but she ignores him. Carmen tries to persuade Don Jose to run away to live with her. He refuses. A soldier comes to arrest Carmen - Don Jose fights him in order to protect her. Before the bull fight Escamillo enters with Carmen on his arm. Don Jose is jealous. Don Jose wants Carmen to be with him but she has said their love is dead and wants to leave. Don Jose stabs her
