College Site development Update

Our students, your children, are amazing and they deserve amazing facilities for their learning. We are therefore delighted to announce some further significant building developments to our College site. Details and images of some of these projects can be found on our website here which we have shown to students in assembly over the past two weeks. We hope this shows you our determination to get the very best education for every student who attends the College.

- 1. **The Elizabeth Lee Building (Green Close)** cost £13.5 million including 450 seat theatre, library, 14 classrooms, 2 ICT suites, 6 Design Technology rooms, 5 laboratories, 3 Drama studios, activity studio, student support hub and SEND space. Completion will be February next year. The building is named after one of our Governors who has served the College for many years.
- 2. **The New Maths Building (Gipsy Lane)** cost £4 million including 8 classroom block linked to the latest Maths block, and will include 4 new outdoor covered areas for students to socialise. Completion will be March next year
- 3. A New AGP Surface will be laid over the summer for the large Astro turf cost £300 000. Completion will be September 22
- 4. We have just won a bid to completely refurbish the **Dance Studio building** cost £280 000. Completion will be November next year
- In addition, over the summer we plan to upgrade some toilets and redesign 5 ICT suites to make them more effective in terms of learning for the students - cost £250 000

We would appreciate your support in regularly reminding your child that they are not permitted into any of the building site areas at any time.
