Academy Days

In November of last year, we informed you that we had been granted two Academy Days to facilitate the move into our new building on Green Close. These days fall on Friday 31st March and Monday 17th April.

These days are non-pupil days to allow staff the time to pack up classrooms, storage rooms and offices ahead of the move during the Easter holiday, and to then unpack again in the new building. Students will therefore break up for the Easter holiday on Thursday 30th March and return to College on Tuesday 18th April for the start of the summer term.

We will take ownership of the new Elizabeth Lee building over Easter with students using the teaching spaces straight after Easter. We are incredibly excited to finally be taking ownership of the state-of-the-art new build after many years of planning followed by two years of construction.

As a reminder, the new block houses state of the art classrooms including science laboratories, design technology workshops, a library, drama studios, gymnasium, reception area, ICT rooms and a new 450 seat theatre. This building will also be the new home for History and Religion in the 15 new classrooms on the top floor as well as lots of new modern toilet facilities. Upon our return after Easter we will inform students of the layout of the new building so they know where to go when they first use it.

We look forward to welcoming you to the new build for events and performances during the summer term.


Tickets are available on sQuid or you can call our Accounts team directly and purchase yours over the phone!
