New Principal Announcement – Chair of Governors

We are delighted to announce that after an extensive recruitment process, we have appointed Tom Inman as our new Principal at the College. Tom has extensive experience of Headship at a large College in Bristol and we look forward to welcoming him in September.

Academy Day and First Day of Summer Term

Monday 17th April is an Academy Day to allow staff to unbox and unpack in their new classrooms and offices in the Elizabeth Lee Building ready for learning to start on Tuesday 18th April when students return for the summer term.

Students have been sent their new timetables for the summer term to accommodate the building move. Staff have also spent time discussing the move with their classes. Parents and Carers of those students whose tutor bases are in the Elizabeth Lee Building have been emailed separately explaining where to meet their tutor on Tuesday 18th April.

Period one on the Tuesday will be a tutor period, during which students will be shown a film of the Elizabeth Lee Building and the maps in their new homework diaries. Students will also have an opportunity to ask their tutor any questions. During this time students will also watch the 'reset' presentations for behaviour and learning.
