Students remaining on site on Tuesday do not need to wear uniform, but wear clothes appropriate for a day at College, and students will be expected to register in the Canteen / Hall 4 at 8:25am, where we will put the students into Teams and will be

Mr Holt is delighted that we have a video message ready to play to the students to launch the day, sent from a member of the United Nations, given from the UN Assembly Hall in Geneva, Switzerland! This is not a typical school experience, but something incredibly significant. Through participating in the Grand Challenge, in line with the University of Exeter's amazing work, the students are taking part in something that is genuinely helping to improve the world! What better way to apply your education!

Again, students do not need to be in uniform, and will follow a slightly adapted timetable, but on all days the break and lunch breaks will be of the same duration, in Hall 4 / Canteen on Gipsy Lane.
