The new Maths Phase 2 building is nearing completion, and we expect to take ownership in October. Internal decoration is ongoing, and the floor coverings are currently being installed. The building houses state of the art Maths classrooms, seminar spaces, work rooms, student toilets, a café and great outdoor space for students to use. This will be another new building that will add first class facilities to our College, totalling an investment of nearly £20million including the new Elizabeth Lee Building on Green Close. We are really looking forward to students and staff benefitting from these excellent facilities and outdoor space this will provide on our Gipsy Lane site. ### Wellbeing support

The College have our own counsellors, and we also work in partnership with two other organisations to provide wellbeing and counselling support to our students on site; Young Devon and CAMHS EHMPs (Education Mental Health Practitioners). Between them all hundreds of individual sessions happen each year. The pastoral teams at school can refer students or give students the details to self-refer to these services. All students have access to Kooth which is an online wellbeing and counselling service and they offer lots of advice Home - Kooth. The CAMHS EHMP team are also helping the College to develop a whole school approach to mental health and wellbeing. They are collecting views from students, parent and carers and staff over the next two weeks. They would like you to complete a survey to help them with this. Students will also receive a survey link via their Classcharts account.
