	TI advised that ECC have identified RAAC in one building on the Gipsy Lane site which affects 4 Science Laboratories.	
	TI explained that the DfE had asked for a survey back in April 2022, which ECC did following the DfE guidance. Further guidance was sent out on Thursday 31.08.23 which had a different age range of buildings in it. MB and ST reviewed the new age range of buildings and found a small extension which had RAAC. The classrooms have been put out of action.	
	Two surveyors have been on site and confirmed ST and MB findings and the estate has been re-checked again and no other areas have been found. The surveyors have said it is safe and not in a bad condition but will be doing further structural testing.
