

### How to confirm your activity

## 1. <u>December</u>: Browse the booklet and choose your activity.

Make sure you consider the **cost** of the trip, whether it is **residential** or not, and the **skills and interests** you might need for the activity.

All activities have a three letter code. Students should choose three, their first choice and a back up second and third choice.



## 2. <u>January</u>: Use the Activity Week Online Choice Form to confirm your choice

(remembering to make your **first**, **second and third** choice by **1**<sup>st</sup> **February**. **Each choice must be different**.)

3. <u>March</u>: Allocation letters will be sent home confirming your activity allocation.

If the activity is free – no further action required.

If the activity has a cost - non-refundable deposits need to be paid via sQuid to confirm your choice by 31st March 2024.

Places on an activity are not confirmed until deposit is paid.



## 4. <u>31<sup>st</sup> May</u>: Final Payment (if applicable) due via sQuid

Payment for an activity with a cost attached is compulsory. Students who receive Free School Meals may be eligible for financial support (please see page 4).

### **SQuid** How to make payment

If you have selected an activity with a cost attached to it, we will write to ask you to pay 10% non-refundable deposit by 31st March 2024 to secure your place.

You will then be able to pay the remainder of the activity off over time, ensuring the full balance is paid by the 31st May 2024.

If you have selected a residential trip, we ask you to pay a £50 nonrefundable deposit to secure your place. You will then be able to pay the remainder of the trip off over time, ensuring the full balance is paid by the 31st May 2024.

In the event that insufficient contributions are made, then an activity may have to be cancelled. We have offered a range of activities both in terms of interest and cost, which will enable everyone to participate.

Further details will be given with the student allocation letter next term. All payments should be made using the student sQuid account, no cash will be accepted.

#### **Crealy Passes**

Students with a season pass for Crealy can use these. The cost of the activity will be reduced by £12, but the pass must be brought on the day. Please tick this option on the online choices form. Please note: the College accepts no responsibility for lost passes.

We reserve the right to withdraw or change activities if circumstances change or to withdraw students who persistently misbehave during the year. All costs in this booklet are approximate and could change depending on the final number of students taking part in 3. each activity. We will give as much notice as possible regarding any cost change.





#### **Off Site Consent**

We will be using the information given on the student Data Collection Form (DCF) for medical consent.

To have permission to go off-site a student needs to have returned a DCF for their current school year 2023/24, or the one directly previous i.e. 2022/23. During the year, please ensure you inform the College of any changes in circumstance or medical conditions.

#### **Attendance**



We regard Activity Week as an important part of your child's education and expect normal attendance. Reasons for non-attendance need to be submitted using an absence request form (S2), as the College has to provide details of all unauthorised absences to the Department for Education. We are unable to authorise absence during Activity Week except for exceptional circumstances.

## All Key Stage 3 students are invited to take part in Activity Week

#### **ClassCharts Points**

Eligibility to attend any activity is based on student **behaviour and engagement** in their learning throughout the Spring and Summer.

In order to secure a place on their chosen activity, students must ensure they have a positive ratio of ClassCharts points from 1<sup>st</sup> January up until the 14<sup>th</sup> June. Students who are on a Stage 3, 4 or 5 behaviour report in July 2024 will not be eligible to attend Activity Week

Any student without a positive ratio of points will have their place on Activity Week reviewed by the Headteacher.

Any student who forfeits their place on Activity Week may not be refunded their deposit for the activity unless the place can be passed on.

Onsite lessons will run during the week for any students who have been unable to attend Activity Week due to poor engagement in their learning and poor behaviour in College.

#### **Expectations during Activity Week**

Students will be asked to sign a conduct agreement regarding expectations and responsibilities during Activity Week. Our students have an excellent reputation for their conduct during trips and visits. We, therefore, want to help ensure the safety of themselves, the accompanying adults and members of the public. Any student who endangers themselves, the group or members of the public may be ejected from the Activity. In exceptional cases, a parent may be requested to collect their child.



### Frequently Asked Questions

#### Why does the College charge for Activity Week?

The cost of activities for every student can total over £100,000 which is a significant percentage of the curriculum budget. The College could not possibly cover the cost of the trips without significant impact on the whole curriculum. However, the week is highly valued by students, staff, Governors, parents and carers as it has a positive impact on learning and engagement. We have ensured a balance between the cost of activities to make them accessible for all and we will endeavour to support those students on Free School Meals and apply with a genuine need for help.

#### Why might some costs be approximate?

The only reason a price would change is due to the provider increasing their costs (we lock these in as soon as we know student numbers) or activities running with less students than quoted (where possible we avoid this as students have a second and third choice option should any activity become over subscribed).

#### What if I change my mind and want my deposit back?

All deposits are non-refundable. However, we will always try to replace students on trips should your child no longer be able to attend. We would require a notice period of 4 weeks prior to the activity taking place.

#### Can my child switch activities if they want to be with a friend?

We release the options for activities before the choice form so students can discuss their options with their family. Once options have been made we will only switch students in extenuating circumstances. We ask you to support us by discussing the possibility that first choices might not be met. Students will always find friends and new friends on activities which is part of the joy of the week.

#### Can I get more information about a specific activity?

More information regarding the running of the week will be sent out in the Summer term. Students will also be invited to a meeting during tutor time where they will meet their trip leader, other students on their trip and have an opportunity to ask any questions.

#### Can I pay the activity off in instalments?

Yes. Once you have received your allocation letter, the payment will open on s Quid. You are then a ble to pay off as much or as little as you like. The balance needs to be settled by 31st May 2024.

#### Why are some trips marked 'Fully Booked'?

Some of the trips are designed for students already doing a specific sport (cricket) and in order for the trip to run, interest needed to be gauged in advance. Tickets also needed to be purchased in advance of the release date of the Activity Week details. Some trips also required large deposits which we did not want to commit to unless we were sure we had enough students interested in attending. The details of these trips were emailed out to parents and carers in advance of the booklet being released.
