### **Year 13 Apply with Bath programme**

**Apply with Bath** is a free, flexible online programme available from September 2025 that supports Year 13 students through the journey of applying to the University of Bath. Students will have the opportunity to chat with undergraduates already studying at Bath and get help with their UCAS application, including 1:1 personal statement support.

To be considered for a place you will need to:

- have obtained at least six GCSEs at grades A\* to B/9 to 6, and at least a grade C/4 in GCSE English and Mathematics
- be on track to achieve the required entry grades to study your chosen subject at Bath
