A two minute silence to mark the 75th anniversary of the end of the Second World War in Europe.

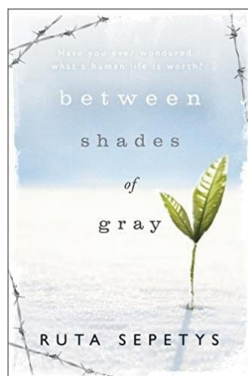
Make bunting for your afternoon tea: see www.english-heritage.org.uk for free downloads, recipes, and instructions how to dance the 'lindy hop'.

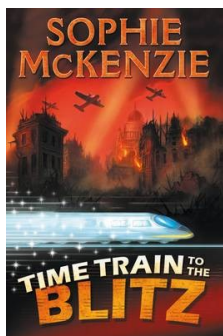

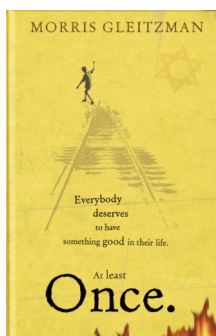
