Move to House System – Monday 23rd June

From Monday, 23rd June we will be making the transition to our new House Pastoral System, with responsibility for Pastoral Care & Provision moving to the 'House Teams', rather than the existing year teams. This will include Year 7.

Making this transition over the last four weeks of the summer term will really support a smooth start to the new academic year in September. Our Heads of House will be writing to parents/carers on this week, outlining key information about how they will support your child moving forwards.

Our new House ties will be available for purchase from Monday, 30 June 2025 via our two uniform suppliers Proserve and Shipshape. Students are welcome to wear their new House ties for the remainder of this academic year if they wish.

The role of Heads of House is to ensure that every student in their House feels a strong sense of belonging, is encouraged to take responsibility for positively contributing to college life and is supported in having the ambition to achieve well. Working closely with tutors, subject teachers, and support staff the House team will monitor your child's progress and pastoral needs, while also being a consistent point of contact for you.

We are excited to welcome Mrs Wright who will be joining us as Head of Lym House in September. In the interim, Assistant Head of House, Mrs Hall will be your point of contact.
