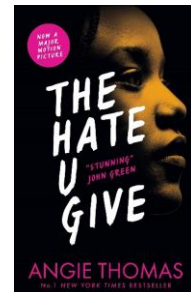
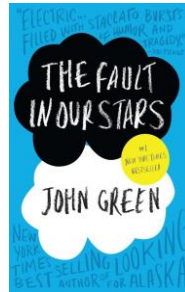
Help support our Tutor Reading Program

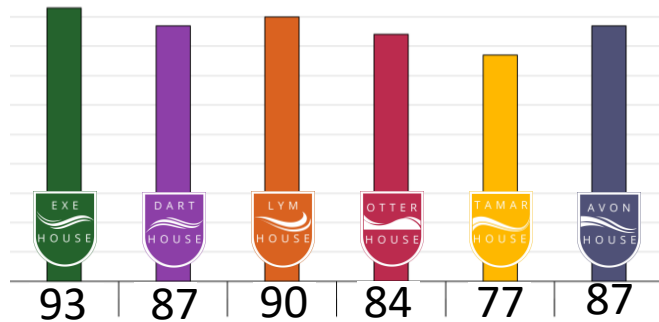
