# Blended Netball

Blended Netball will launch during NSSW 2020, it's been a long time in the making.

Blended Netball is a peer to peer programme which sees mainstream girls delivering netball to girls with Special Educational Needs (SEN).

In an average state secondary school there are 70 SEN girls, the majority of which do not receive netball as part of the regular school curriculum. Whilst the girls are learning the 'hard' skills of netball they will in return be giving the opportunity for mainstream girls to develop the 'soft' skills of leadership, communication and empathy.

Blended Netball is designed to be delivered entirely by mainstream teenage girls. Find out more about and register your interest [here](#).
