Important Letter from Mr Inman

You may be aware of reports of an incident of sexual assault which occurred off the school site last week.

The safety and wellbeing of our students is always our top priority and at the heart of all decisions we make. We have been working closely with the local Police on this matter and following their guidance regarding the sharing of this information and their investigation.

While incidents of this nature are thankfully rare in our community, we understand that hearing about them can be concerning.

As a school, we work closely with the Police and other external partners, and we will always share information about potential local risks as soon as we are able, in line with police guidance, to help keep our young people safe.

I recognise that news like this may cause worry or raise questions for some children. If your child feels concerned or needs any additional support in the coming days they can speak to a trusted adult in school, such as their form tutor, Head of House, or a member of the safeguarding team. Our pastoral team will also be on hand to support students and we'll be speaking to all students today to remind them of the support available.
