



# FREQUENTLY *ASKED* QUESTIONS

**What time should students arrive?**

The road will close at approximately 5:30pm. Students can start queuing at the road block (located at Morton Crescent) between then and 6:30pm. At 6:30pm, the road will be opened by staff for the arrival procession to begin. This will approximately last around an hour and a half and the road will be re opened at 8:00pm.

**Security and supervision on the night?**

Due to Prom being a private event, there will be an external security company present all evening. All students will be bagged checked on the door like any other under 18 event and prohibited/illegal items such as alcohol, vapes, weapons etc will be confiscated at the door and disposed of appropriately. Along with the security team, a large number of ECC staff will also be present all evening. The security team will not permit entry to any student arriving or considered under the influence and no refunds will be given.

A complimentary large buffet will be available to all students with vegetarian, vegan and gluten free options. Along with a mocktail on arrival. (Two flavours to pick from) Students can also bring cash or card to pay for soft drinks throughout the evening at the designated student bar inside the Pavilion.
