We look forward to celebrating the end of the year with you with an exciting trio of trips during activity week. Please take the time to read the information below as there is some essential advice and information needed for each trip location.

Times and Travel Arrangements

Students are to meet at **8:15am each morning in Elizabeth Lee Theatre on Green Close site.** Please do not be late as we have a scheduled time to leave. Registers will be taken before boarding the coaches. We will be travelling by coach and will arrive back at the College for 3pm each day. ***Parents/Carers have already confirmed that students can swim for the activities involved in CQW.***

Crealy- Wednesday 8th July

Students will be given a wrist band which they must wear at all times. A meeting place as is the case in all of the parks will be allocated for regular check ins.

There are food outlets inside Crealy or students may prefer to bring their own packed lunch. Students eligible for free school meals will have packed lunches proved by the College. There are gift shops but students bring any money or valuables at their own risk. Students will **NOT** be allowed to leave the Crealy site.

Quaywest – Thursday 9th July

Upon arrival at Quaywest, students will be issued with a wristband that they need to wear at all times. They will then be able to change and go straight onto the water. Small change will be needed (20p returnable) for the lockers in the changing rooms. They need swimwear (**no bikinis**) and a towel. No jewellery or glasses may be worn.

It is strongly recommended that students apply sun cream and re apply throughout the day if the weather is hot. Also, a bottle of water and sun hats are recommended for when students are not in the water. **Students should bring a t-shirt** to wear over their swimwear to prevent friction burns to their back on the bigger water slides.



There are food outlets inside Quaywest or students may prefer to bring their own packed lunch. Students eligible for free school meals will have packed lunches provided by the College. Students will **NOT** be allowed to leave the Quaywest site.

Woodlands – Friday 10th July

Upon arrival students will be escorted into the park. Students will need to check in with staff every 45 mins-1 hour at allocated bases. There is little or no mobile phone reception at Woodlands Park so students must make sure that they have a watch or some method of keeping an eye on the time so that they can meet and get back to college in good time for the school buses.

It is strongly recommended that students apply sun cream and re-apply throughout the day if the weather is hot as there is limited space indoors or shade.

Also, a bottle of water and sun hats are recommended. There are food outlets inside Woodlands or students may prefer to bring their own packed lunch. Students eligible for free school meals will have packed lunches provided by the College. Students will **NOT** be allowed to leave the Woodlands site.

Medical Conditions

It is important that staff are made aware of any medical condition that may affect students and that trip leaders know what action to take in the event of a medical emergency.

Therefore, a Data Collection Form will need to be completed for **ALL students** taking part in this activity. Please ensure you inform the college of any changes (medical, contact details etc.) so that our records are up to date.
