Times and Daily Arrangements

All activities will take place on the College site during the normal school day on Wednesday 8th, Thursday 9th and Friday 10th July 2026.

Students should arrive onsite as usual and make their way directly to their allocated activity meeting point each morning. Registers will be taken by activity leaders at the start of each session.

The College day will run to normal timings, and all school buses will operate as usual at the beginning and end of each day.

Activity Meeting Points

Yondr pouches will continue to be used throughout Activity Week as per normal College expectations. Students should ensure they bring their Yondr pouches with them each day and follow the usual procedures regarding mobile phone storage.

Food and Refreshments

College canteens will be open and operating as normal throughout Activity Week.

Students may purchase food and drinks from the canteens or bring their own packed lunch. Students eligible for free school meals will continue to receive their entitlement as usual.
