Equipment needed for Laser.

Students should wear sensible outdoor clothing that it is acceptable to damage. (eg. Combat trousers, long sleeve top). Old trainers or walking boots would be recommended as there is plenty of mud to jump through. Camouflage overalls are supplied at Skirmish. A change of clothing and shoes is also recommended as muddy wet clothing may be uncomfortable on the return journey.

Eating Arrangements for Laser.

Student must bring their own packed lunch and plenty of drink as the day will be very energetic. Some food and drinks are available at Skirmish if you wish to bring a small amount of money.
